

The key to feeding birds is understanding who eats what.

Most seed-eating birds have individual preferences that can be used to attract specific birds to particular foods and feeders. This is the basis for the Lyric family of bird specific mixtures that includes Lyric Cardinal, Lyric Chickadee, and Lyric Woodpecker wild bird mixes. Offering a variety of mixtures and adding more feeding stations can reduce competition and increase the number of seed-eating species that visit your backyard.

Why a special mix for finches?

Finches differ from most songbirds that visit backyard feeders in that they eat seeds almost exclusively all year long. During the nesting season finches continue to eat seed and even feed them to their nestlings. This makes Lyric Finch Mix an ideal year-round food.

What birds eat Lyric Finch Small Songbird Mix?

The most widely distributed and well known North American finch is the American Goldfinch. It is often called a wild canary. From May through September the male's brilliant yellow and black plumage makes it unmistakable. Females are a more muted olive green. During the non-breeding season, males assume a female-like winter plumage. The photos below show the variety of birds that have bills well suited for the finely sized seeds of Lyric Finch Mix.

Is there a "best" feeder for Lyric Finch Small Songbird Mix?

All of the seeds in Lyric Finch Mix are tiny. If placed in an ordinary tube feeder the mix flows too freely the seed will be wasted. We recommend using a finch or Nyjer® seed tube feeder or finch sock. These special tube feeders have small seed ports that require the bird to pull the food out one piece at a time. Few other birds other than finches are capable of removing the food from these small openings. Lyric Finch Mix is an excellent value used in finch feeders. Each pound contains thousands of tiny, nutritious morsels. You can attract other birds when using Lyric Finch Mix in hopper feeders or on the ground. Chickadees, titmice and nuthatches love bits of sunflower kernels. Sparrows enjoy canary seed and small golden millet seed. Mourning Doves often forage the ground and will eat Nyjer® seed.
